At the end, students will create a flag and write the equivalent fractions they included.







Color the top row red. Keep the bottom row white.










Vatican City's Flag

Color the left column yellow. Keep the right column white.






Color the top row red, the second row blue, the third row yellow, and the fourth row green.









United Arab Emirates' Flag


Color the left row red. Color the top row green. Keep the middle row white. Color the bottom row black.







#### Panama's Flag

Color the top left box white., the top right red, the bottom left blue, and the bottom right white.










#### <u>Uganda's Flag</u>

Color the top row black, the second row yellow, the third row red, the fourth row black, the fifth row yellow, and the sixth row red.




Costa Rica's Flag


Color the top row blue, the second row white, the third row red, the fourth row white, and the fifth row blue.




#### Latvia's Flag

Color the top row red. Keep the middle row white. Color the bottom row red.









#### Chile's Flag


Color the top left box blue. Color the bottom row red. The rest of the flag is white.


#### <u>Taiwan's Flag</u>
